HIGH RISE BRIDGE STOPPAGES PLANNED DURING WEEKENDS IN APRIL

Motorists should expect delays and plan alternate routes

CHESAPEAKE – Motorists should expect numerous traffic stoppages at the High Rise Bridge on **Saturdays and Sundays in April** for Dominion Energy work in support of the I-64 Southside Widening and High Rise Bridge Project.

Traffic will be slowed prior to the stoppages, which will occur **between 6 a.m. and 6 p.m. on weekends** and may last as long as 20 minutes. Motorists should expect delays and are urged to plan alternate routes, including South Military Highway and the Gilmerton Bridge. The stoppages begin April 7.

The traffic stoppages will allow Dominion Energy to pull power cables across I-64 as utility crews replace two transmission structures. Taller structures are required to provide adequate clearance for construction of the interstate and bridge project.
